District Department of Transportation and DC Circulator policy is to assure that no person shall on the grounds of race, color, national origin, gender, age, or disability as provided in Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and related statutes, be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which DDOT receives or has received federal financial assistance.

If you believe you have been discriminated against based on Title VI's nondiscrimination regulations or related statutes, you may file a written complaint within 180 days of the date of the alleged discriminatory act(s), or at the time you become aware of the discriminatory act(s).
